Notice of Availability of Partially Recirculated Draft Environmental Impact Report (EIR)

The California Department of Toxic Substances Control (DTSC) is recirculating the Biological Resources section of the Draft EIR for the **PG&E Topock Compressor Station Soil Investigation Project**. DTSC invites the public to provide comments on revised portions of the Biological Resources section of the Draft EIR.

The modified Biological Resources section further evaluates the potential environmental impacts of the Project on special status bat species and Nelson's bighorn sheep, and identifies feasible mitigation measures to ensure all impacts would be reduced to a less than significant level.

The PG&E Topock Compressor Station is located in the Mojave Desert approximately 12 miles southeast of the City of Needles, California. The Project involves soil investigation activities including soil sampling and sample analysis, bench scale tests, pilot studies, geotechnical evaluations, and plant and biota sampling.
